Dear TAS Family:

Do you have a child who would like to attend a Jewish camp, Jewish volunteer program, or an Israel program? Sisterhood and MoTAS are excited to once again help make dreams come true. Sisterhood and MoTAS support many programs as part of our commitment to our Temple community and we welcome your membership. While all families are encouraged to apply, preference will be given to the children of active members of Sisterhood and/or MoTAS.

Sisterhood and the Men of TAS (MoTAS) have limited resources and therefore we encourage you to apply to other funding sources as well. Other sources include the Foundation for Jewish Camp: One Happy Camper (www.onehappycamper.org), Peachy Levy Scholarships for URJ camps, (www.urj.org/youth/levyscholarship), Jewish Free Loan at the JCC (www.jfla.org) and of course, the camps themselves.

Parents/guardians and campers should complete this application together. Service hours are required to receive a campership. All volunteer hours must be performed for Sisterhood or MoTAS events only. *General Temple and outside community volunteer hours will not qualify for this Campership program.* See the rules on the following pages for details.

Applications should be placed in a sealed envelope, addressed to "Camperships" and placed in the "Campership" envelope in the Sisterhood mailbox in the Chapel closet, no later than noon Tuesday, March 26, 2019. All applications will remain confidential.

All recipients of a 2018 campership are required to write thank you notes to both the Sisterhood and to MoTAS by December 31, 2018. If thank you notes are not received, a 2019 campership request WILL NOT be honored.

Checks will be made out and sent to the appropriate camp or program by April 15, 2019. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to contact us.

We look forward to seeing your child/children volunteering at our Sisterhood and MoTAS events and contributing to funding their Jewish camp experience of a lifetime.

Temple Ahavat Shalom Sisterhood/Men of TAS Campership/Scholarship Guidelines

Campership/Scholarship Requirements:

◆ Application Deadline:

Applications must be placed in a sealed envelope, addressed to "Camperships" and turned into the Religious School Office, or placed in the "Campership" envelope in the Sisterhood mailbox in the Chapel closet, no later than noon Tuesday, March 26, 2018. All applications will remain confidential. All volunteer hours must be completed at that time. (Please complete hours early on when more volunteer opportunities are available.)

♦ Limit:

Only one Campership/Scholarship will be given to a child per year (July-June). Camperships/Scholarships are only for Jewish programs.

♦ Participation:

Families must be Temple Members in good standing (dues paid up-to-date).

♦ Service:

Each applicant must complete service for **Sisterhood or MoTAS** events.

Other Temple events and community service do not qualify for campership service.

Five service hours are required for grades 5-12; three hours for grades K-4.

Children grades K-4 must be accompanied by an adult during all service hours. Hours must be completed between 6/1/2018 and 3/26/2019.

- Jewish Women's Theater (November 10)
- Sisterhood Dreidels & Gelt packaging (December 1)
- Sisterhood Bingotini (date TBD)
- MoTAS Purim Carnival food booth (date TBD)
- MoTAS Yom Hashoah candle packaging (date TBD)
- Sisterhood and MoTAS Mailings (occasionally)
